SPORT HORSE PROSPECT PURSE ENROLLMENT

The Region 4 Sport Horse Show Committee is pleased to present the Region 4 Sport Horse Prospect Purse Jackpot, an exciting opportunity for handlers to win money while showcasing the most athletic young fillies, geldings, and colts at the Region 4 Sport Horse Championship Show. The Sport Horse Prospect Purse Jackpot is split into two sport horse in hand jackpot classes for horses age two and under and divided by Purebred and Half Arabian/Anglo Arabian entries. Jackpot money will be divided up among the Top 5 winners in each class and consist of each class's jackpot enrollment fees, in addition to money provided by jackpot sponsors.

GENERAL RULES

- Current AHA Membership with Competition Card is required for participation.
- All entries must be Purebred or Half Arabian/ Anglo Arabians registered with AHA or CAHR.
- The jackpot classes will be a combination of yearling and two-year-old fillies, geldings, and colts and will not be split except for by Purebred and Half Arabian/Anglo Arabian registration status.
- Entries will be shown in hand on the triangle in accordance with ARABIAN SPORT HORSE SUBCHAPTER AR-17 of the USEF Rulebook, AR179-183, except two judges will evaluate each entry. The judges will collaborate on one set of scores and comments, which will be recorded on one scoresheet. (This is an exception to AR182.1)
- Jackpot payout divided: 5 or more entries: champion 35%, reserve 25%, third/ fourth 15%, fifth 10%. 4 entries: champion 40%, reserve 30%, remaining entries 15%. 3 entries: champion 50%, reserve 35%, remaining entry 15%. 2 entries: champion 60%, reserve 40%. 1 entry: champion 100%.
- Winners will be mailed a check within ten days of the completion of the show. Ribbons will be handed out at the show.
- No refunds of jackpot enrollment fees will be issued.

Online entries are accepted via Gaitkeeper at www.gaitkeeper.com. There is no fee to use this service – help us provide you a better competitor experience by entering online. **THIS IS THE PREFERRED METHOD OF ENTRY.** DO NOT SUPPLY CREDIT CARD INFO. This show does not process credit cards. Entering online helps us ensure the accuracy of your entry and personal information. Competitors are responsible to provide valid membership numbers on the entry form for all horse, owner, rider, and trainer names listed on the entry form. **AHA, USEF and USDF membership is verified electronically** (no copies of cards, registration papers, etc. needed) if valid membership numbers are provided on the entry form. You may be asked to provide copies of your membership documents if your memberships cannot be verified for any reason. **Please verify USEF and USDF horse registration when you check in.** The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.

To enter by e-mail/ground mail, call secretary for entry form. Copies of the horse's registration certificate and all current membership cards must be enclosed with the emailed/paper entry and date stamped, postmarked or hand delivered to the show secretary beginning June 20th and **no later than July 5th**. No entries will be taken over the phone or by fax, and **no entries accepted without payment.** Entry Confirmation will be sent via email to the owner & trainer email address on file with AHA. Please review it as soon as it arrives to avoid delays in the show office when you arrive at the show.

Cancelled Classes: Classes with no entries by closing date may be cancelled. If an entire division has no entries – for example, if there are no Carriage Driving entries in the pre-show – expect that that judge will be released from their contract and those classes will not be available for late entry.

Late Entries: Late entries will be accepted after the closing date if space is available, upon payment of an additional late entry fee.

Payments All fees must be paid in US Dollars. Full payment is required for the balance of the entry for an entry to be processed. Region 4 AHA accepts checks and PayPal. Region 4 does not do Venmo or accept credit cards. Do not send cash with mailed entries. Submission of entry to us is your intent to show and acceptance of our show policies. Postdated checks will not be accepted. Entries not accompanied by fees will be considered late and not entered until fees are received including any late or post entry fees. In fairness to all exhibitors, open checks are not allowed for the initial entry. If an open check is sent, it will be closed for the amount due at the time the entry is processed and will be deposited **Check should be made payable to "Region 4 AHA"**. All payments will be deposited immediately after closing date and thereafter upon receipt. Foreign competitors checks must indicate payment in USD.

Post Entries: Previously entered horses may fill scratches and add classes up to the start of competition, if scheduling permits. No late entry fee will be required but will be required to pay a post entry fee in addition to the normal class fee.

Policy for Accepting Post Entries and Filling Scratches in classes: Must be eligible for class. Must have previously entered in competition as a competing or non-competing horse. Must register with secretary and put name on wait list.

Scratched Classes: After the close of entries, horses may be scratched from one or more classes at the owner's option. No fees will be refunded. Please scratch horses with the Show Secretary. If you don't show up for an assigned ride time, this Competition reserves the right to scratch you from all remaining dressage rides and offer them to other exhibitors.

Wait-listed Entries: Entries received after closing date are not guaranteed accommodation. For that matter, neither are entries received before closing date, if all times are filled. **Enter early!** Every effort is being made to accommodate all those who want to participate, but since there are a limited number of slots for Dressage, Western Dressage and Sport Horse In-Hand, those classes may fill before the closing date. If that happens, entries will be placed on a waiting list in order received.

ATTENTION COMPETITORS

Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct applicable numbers (AHA, USDF, USEF & WDAA) for horse, owner, riders, handlers, and trainer, before the day(s) of the competition.

The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.





DEVONWOOD EQUESTRIAN CENTRE

Areas which are off limits. We are renting only part of the facility. Please respect “Arena Closed” signs. Please stay on bridle paths. The area set aside for hand-grazing is under the announcer’s tower.

Arenas & Footing. Schooling hours will be posted at show office and published with ride times.

All arenas, lunge rings and bridle paths close at 8:30PM

- Six outdoor arenas, three competition and three warm-ups; two indoor arenas, one competition and one warm-up.
- Memorial: Risohorse® Ebb & Flow Surface by Dammann (Hydro-Active Sand Arena)
- Sylvan: Equi-Base (Sand and Geotek Fabric over rubber matting)
- Terrace: Risohorse® Ebb & Flow Surface by Dammann (Hydro-Active Sand Arena)
- Footpaths are packed and leveled 1/4" Minus Crushed Gravel

Children & Pets. Absolutely **NO DOGS ALLOWED** on show grounds, except [Medical Assistance Animals/Service Dogs](#), as permitted by law. Children must be supervised at all times. Emotional support animals (ESA) are not permitted. If you choose to bring a non-equine to the show, it must remain outside the Main Gates at all times. For your animals’ safety, please leave them at home. Do not leave them in the car or trailer as temperatures can quickly become dangerous to their health.

Food may not be readily available on the show grounds. there will be limited concessions available on-site. There are a variety of restaurants within a ten-minute drive.

Feed & hay are available from local retailers. They will not be available on the grounds.

Lungeing. Use the sand warm-up by the lower stabling when classes are not in session.(YES, you may have to get up early to get this done. **Round pens are off limits unless specified day of show.** No free lungeing or turn-out in lunge pens. No lungeing is permitted anywhere else on the grounds.

Office hours. The show office will be open Thursday from 2-8PM; thereafter, from one hour before first class until 30 minutes after the last class of the day for the remainder of the show. Show office phone is (360) 949-9333.

RV Parking/Camping. A limited number of RV parking spaces with electrical hookups are available for purchase; spaces will not be assigned. Entire rig must fit within space, both length and width, to ensure clear fire lane. Tents, trailers and tow vehicles may park outside the main facility gates at no fee. Electrical service is available at the end of each stall row as a courtesy on a first come, first served basis as available. RVs and horse trailers with Premium RV/Trailer permits are welcome to hook-up/run an extension cord from 7PM to 7AM daily. Extension cords must be unplugged and stowed during competition hours. Please, out of courtesy to your neighbors, only quiet generators. One plug-in per outlet, splitters and piggy-backing/daisy-chaining is strictly forbidden. You’ll blow out the electrical system and we will all be mad! No water hookups.

Security. Exhibitors are advised that it is their responsibility to secure valuables and their stall areas. DWEC, Region 4 AHA, its members, agents, employees and volunteers accept no responsibility for losses sustained or caused by any exhibitor.

Sharps Containers for medical waste (needles, syringes, etc.) are mounted in the barn aisles and the show office. A \$100 fine per violation will be passed on to the violator for medical waste found in your area or if you are found disposing of materials improperly.

Smoking (including vaping) prohibited everywhere on the grounds. DevonWood is a 100% smoke- and vape-free facility. If you smoke or vape, please do it inside your vehicle, outside the main gates.

Stabling. For horses' and exhibitors’ safety, (1) each horse brought onto the grounds must have an assigned stall, and (2) aisles must be kept clear — no tents, canopies , etc. in aisles regardless of aisle ownership or permission from competitors. All stalls are box stalls with permanent stall doors. MB, SB and E/F stalls have sliding/locking stall doors. LB Stalls have swinging/latching stall doors. Shavings may not be brought in from outside sources. Violators will be fined. We recommend 3 bags per stall minimum. Straw and other bedding materials prohibited. Stalls may not be resold/sublet.

Stabling fees listed are for THURSDAY NOON through Sunday evening. If you arrive early without making prior arrangements, the gate will be locked and admission denied. Early arrivals may be accepted on a case-by-case basis and must be approved by and contracted with DevonWood Equestrian Centre, LLC. Please contact Lisa Kolke via e-mail: horseshownumber@gmail.com for details.

Out-of-State Horses. The regulations do change periodically. Oregon Department of Agriculture, (503) 986-4680, has the most recent information. The person who has care and custody of the horse is responsible for being aware of, and complying with, the regulations when taking animal(s) into another state. Your veterinarian can help with this process.

Directions. From I-5 south from Portland/north from Salem to Sherwood/Tualatin exit, #289. West on Nyberg Road (Nyberg Road becomes Tualatin/Sherwood Hwy) and go five miles to Hwy 99W. Turn south and go three miles to 25033 SW Pacific Hwy, on your right just past Brookman/Chapman Rd. Gate code will be shared via confirmation e-mail and posted at main gate on day of arrival.

Coming from the south? To avoid traffic in Tualatin/Sherwood and if your rig is not too long to make a U-turn, you may prefer to: Take Aurora/Donald exit #278. West on Ehlen/McKay Rd. 6.5 miles to end. Right (north) on Hwy 219 3.4 mi to first traffic signal. Right on Springbrook 1 mi to Hwy 99E. Right on Hwy 99E. After approx. 4 miles, just past railroad trestle, see DevonWood entrance on left. This is a four-lane divided highway; make a U-turn at Brookman/Chapman Rd (unprotected turn) or continue north .75 mi to Sunset Blvd (traffic signal, protected U-turn).



A WORD ABOUT HORSE HEALTH

Vaccinations/Coggins: USEF Vaccination Rule (GR844). Competition Management reserves the right to review vaccination documentation. Non-compliant entries may be quarantined or denied permission to unload and will not be allowed to compete nor to mingle with other horses. **No refunds will be given if right to compete is denied because the Vaccination Record is missing or incomplete.** Whether the horse is vaccinated by a veterinarian or by an owner or agent, or is exempt for medical or age reasons, documentation is required; see USEF GR844 for details.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; and 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

ACTIVE EQUINE CANADA Active Equine Canada exhibitors who are EC Sport License holders in good standing and with a Bronze, Silver, Gold or Platinum Sport License will be given a USEF Competing Membership at no cost for the purpose of competing in USEF licensed competitions. All USEF Competing Members who are 18 years of age or older must annually complete the SafeSport Training. For information about obtaining a USEF Competition membership, EC Sport License holders should contact sportlicences@equestrian.ca or memberservices@usef.org.

ANYONE ELSE COMPETING IN AN AMATEUR CLASS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SHOW PROOF OF AMATEUR STATUS ISSUED BY USEF. Only active Federation members [Competition memberships] may obtain amateur status. Every person who has reached his/her 19th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation Arabian rules must possess current amateur status issued by the Federation. Exceptions • Any person who has not reached his/her 19th birthday as of December 1 of the previous calendar year is a Junior Exhibitor; all Junior Exhibitors are considered amateurs for competition purposes. Proof of amateur status is not required for Opportunity classes. (GR1307.1 and AR 110.6)

REMINDER: US EQUESTRIAN SAFE SPORT –All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies.

Any individual signing an entry blank as Trainer or Coach, must have completed the Safe Sport Training prior to the first day of competition. (GR310) and be in compliance through the end of the competition.

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

AHA Competition Card Requirements • All riders, drivers, owners, agents and handlers who exhibit horses in the show ring or sign the entry form as the responsible party for any individual's horses at the show must be AHA COMPETITION level members with competition cards. **If the recorded owner is an entity (Farm, Ranch, Syndicate, etc.) it must have a current AHA Business membership.** AHA does not permit Single Event Memberships at AHA Regional Championship Shows. An AHA COMPETITION membership is required for all, including walk/trot riders. Lead Line or Parent/Guardian signing for minors are exempt.

WDAA MEMBERSHIP

New rule WD102.8 states, "To be eligible to participate and/or compete as an exhibitor, owner, lessee, agent, coach, or trainer in any Western Dressage class or at any Western Dressage Federation Licensed Competition persons must be active members of WDAA (westerndressageassociation.org) or pay a non-member fee equal to the price of an annual membership for each competition." Lessees are considered owners in connection with this membership requirement. In the event of an entry under multiple ownership, only one owner need be a Member or pay a non-member fee.

Joining WDAA instead of paying a non-member fee is a better value for you!

MEMBERSHIP

USDF Membership Benefits: USDF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and promotion of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the *USDF Member Guide* or the USDF website at www.usdf.org.

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$100), 5-years (\$400), or life (\$2,000). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21 birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$80). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards Program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$280) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$55). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded but will NOT be counted towards Adequan/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$95. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$140) is eligible for Adequan/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USDF

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

- On the USDF website: www.usdf.org. You can submit the application online or download the form.
- In the show office at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions classified by USEF as Dressage Competitions, and Regular Competitions which are open to all breeds.

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day. 06/25



RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. EACH PARTICIPANT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR KNOWLEDGE OF AND IS SUBJECT TO THE USEF RULE BOOK. THE USEF RULE BOOK IS AVAILABLE AT www.usef.org

Rules, Violations and Penalties.

1. Membership, registration and other rule violations will subject the violator to be disqualified.
2. All classes are to be conducted in accordance with the rules of AHA. Judging, class specifications, rules and conduct shall be in accordance with the current USEF/EC Rulebook.
3. In the event of any rule violation which necessitates a disqualification of any entry, Show Management will make the necessary corrections and submit the results to the AHA office.
4. All decisions made by the Judge and/or Show Management are deemed final and cannot be protested.

Abbreviations. If the class title does not list the breed, the class is open to Arabian, Half Arabian and Anglo Arabians.

AATR = Adult Amateur to Ride (19 yrs & over)

HA/AA = Half-Arabian / Anglo-Arabian

ATH = Amateur to Handle (any age, adults & juniors)

JTR = Junior to ride (18 & under)

ATR = Amateur to Ride (any age, adults & juniors)

TOC = Test of Choice (You pick any one test of the level)

Amateur Status. Adults competing in classes for amateurs must meet the criteria for amateur certification as defined by USEF.

Awards of Trophies and Ribbons • Awards must be picked up and signed for at the awards room. Awards room will be open while classes are in session only. Unclaimed awards will not be mailed. A full Top Five will be awarded regardless of the number of entries in a class. However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed 5 awards) will receive Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes payouts, AHA Horse Achievement Awards, Amateur Achievement Awards, High Point Horse Achievement Awards, High Point Amateur Achievement Awards and Distance Award points. All Top Five Awards will qualify for the corresponding national championship.

Region 4 Championship Classes: Champion –Champion Ribbon, Garland. Reserve Champion –Reserve Champion Ribbon. Balance of Top 5 will receive Top 5 ribbon. ABS Sweepstakes ribbons will be awarded to enrolled horses in ABS Sweepstakes classes. **Region 4 Sport Horse Prospect Purse Classes** – Top Ten ribbons to 10th. Champion –Champion Ribbon, Garland. Reserve Champion – Plaque, Reserve Champion Ribbon. For purse distribution, refer to the Prospect Program rules on website: <https://aharegion4.com/sport-horse>.

Call for Classes. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to follow how quickly classes are progressing and to promptly present themselves when the gate person calls for their class. The public address system is considered a courtesy to the exhibitors, and its function or coverage of areas cannot be guaranteed. No refunds will be made solely because of sound system inadequacy or failure.

Changes of Handler/Rider. Please fill out a handler or rider change form, including signatures, correct association numbers and required documentation, in the show office prior to the start of the class. This will ensure that points are recorded correctly for qualifying purposes.

Delay of Class (more commonly known as a "Gate Hold"). In classes where horses compete collectively, when it is found that a gate hold must be requested by an exhibitor, such request shall be made to the Paddock Manager or "Lord of the Ring" (gate person) prior to the close of judging of the class immediately before the class requiring the gate hold. The reason for the request must be stated. The gate hold will be a maximum of three (3) minutes. In classes where horses compete individually, failure to check in with the Paddock Manager or to enter the competition arena at the assigned time will result in elimination.

Drug and medication rule • Refer to USEF Chapter 4, GR 408-411. The official Medication Report Form is now online at: <https://competitions.usef.org/drugs-and-meds/medication-report-form/usef>.

Electronic Communication Devices. The use of earphones and/or other electronic communication devices is strictly prohibited while competing and such usage is penalized by elimination. There is no penalty for having cell phones or other electronic devices worn or carried in clothing while competing as long as they are not in use. Electronic devices that transmit and/or receive information may be used in the stabling area and in warm up areas, **however, only one earphone or similar device is permitted while mounted or lunging.** The unsafe use of electronic devices, as determined by the competition Technical Delegate in their sole discretion, including cell phones, with or without earphones/buds, while mounted is prohibited in all areas designated for schooling and exercise, and while lunging horses on competition grounds. Exception: medical devices, such as hearing aids are allowed to be used for the medical condition for which they are prescribed.

Motorized Vehicles: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/ guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

Refusal/Removal of Entries. Management reserves the right to hold classes conditionally, or cancel entries of any contestant, as stated in USEF Rules. The show committee reserves the right to remove any agent, owner, groom, trainer, manager, coach or handler, horse or rider from the show who has shown an objectionable attitude or behavior towards its management, or previous unsportsmanlike behavior, without being liable for compensation or damages. The Region 4 AHA Board of Delegates has directed that entries must be refused from anyone who has an outstanding obligation to a Region 4 affiliated club or show. Refunds will not be given to exhibitors evicted for cause.

Scheduling and Ride Times Classes may be split or combined at show management’s discretion. Preliminary Schedules for Dressage, Western Dressage and Sport Horse In-Hand will be posted on the Region 4 website. Official in-hand and ride times will be posted in the show office by Noon prior to the first day of competition. Classes may not necessarily be run in the order listed. Responsibility for obtaining ride times from show management remains with the competitor. It is the responsibility of the rider to immediately inform the management of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving the schedule. **Do not wait until you get to the show !!**

Scheduling Changes. Management reserves the right to make changes of arenas, judges or class order to facilitate time schedule and conditions. Competition management reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes at its discretion. All changes will be posted on the announcement board in the office and the appropriate announcements made during the competition. Classes with no entries by closing date may be canceled. If entries warrant, additional judges may be hired.

Show Management reserves the right to vary or add officials and refuse any entry for a cause; to disqualify any exhibitor and/or his or her horse for cause; to cause an exhibitor to forfeit his or her ribbons and winnings for cause; to return any entry and/or stall fee before or during the show for cause; all without being liable for damage or compensation. Show management reserves the right to make any changes deemed necessary for the safe and efficient conduct of this competition.

Weather/Acts of God/Accidents or Emergency Policy: Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, Accidents or Emergencies. Every effort will be made to reschedule with priority given to regional group classes; in-hand and dressage. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, Accidents or Emergencies.

Scoring Systems. If a mathematical scoring error on the score sheet is discovered, it must be reported to Show Secretary within one hour of the official posting of the scores from the last scored class of that competition day or the error will stand with no change in class placings. Please claim all dressage and western dressage test sheets and In-Hand score sheets at the show; they will not be mailed.

Competition management reserves the right to modify the contents of this prize list after initial publication.

Dressage classes 150 & 409 require proof that horse/rider combination has earned a score of 63% or higher in the highest test of the freestyle level or any test of a higher level *prior to this competition* [DR129.9]. This pre-requisite score may be earned in open or Arabian USEF Dressage competition [AR173.2k].

TEST OF CHOICE. The entire class (*i.e.*, all sections 155.9-155.4) will be pinned as one class. A horse may be entered in a class only once. You must specify freestyle level (section) on entry.

MUSIC. Bring a thumbdrive or email MP3 download file to juliegelderman23@gmail.com before 7/30. Clearly label with rider & horse names, bridle/back number, freestyle level. Backup is recommended for DR; required for WD.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and _____ ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF INHERENT RISKS: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with equine activities, including but not limited to horseback riding and equestrian sport, are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").
